

# **Air Monitoring**

Figure 1. Air Quality Index (AQI) Summary for 2016 Year to Date



- "Moderate" Days in April:
  - Ozone: 12 (4/4, 4/5, 4/6, 4/7, 4/8, 4/9, 4/20, 4/22, 4/23, 4/27, 4/28, 4/30)
  - PM<sub>2.5</sub>: 5 (4/11, 4/25, 4/26, 4/28, 4/29)
- Feb. Max 8-hour ozone (O<sub>3</sub>) concentration: 69 ppb (99% of NAAQS)
- Feb. Max 24-hour fine particulate matter (PM<sub>2.5</sub>) concentration: 24.5 μg/m<sup>3</sup> (70% of NAAQS)
- Feb. Max 1-hour nitrogen dioxide (NO<sub>2</sub>) concentration: 52.3 ppb (52% of 1-hr NAAQS)
- Feb. Max 1-hour sulfur dioxide (SO<sub>2</sub>) concentration: 2.2 ppb (2.9% of NAAQS)

### State & Federal Updates

- 2015 Ozone NAAQS Designations and Implementation:
  - CAPCOG submitted comments to TCEQ on designation recommendations on 4/11;
  - Joint CAPCOG-Clean Air Coalition/AACOG-AIR Executive Committee resolution submitted adopted 4/29, submitted to TCEQ as a commend on designation recommendations;
  - On April 28, 2016, EPA posted its Ozone Designations Mapping Tool to assist in the designation process: <u>https://www.epa.gov/ozone-designations/ozone-designations-guidance-and-data</u>.
  - August 3, 2016: TCEQ Commissioners scheduled to make recommendations on designations to the Governor;
  - October 1, 2016: Designation recommendations from Governor due to EPA;
  - Fall 2016: Proposed Implementation Rule;
- PM National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS) Periodic Review:
  - Last PM NAAQS review was completed in December 2012;
  - Under the Clean Air Act, EPA is supposed to review each NAAQS every five years (i.e., by December 2017 for the PM NAAQS);
  - On April 19, 2016, EPA released the Draft Integrated Review Plan (IRP) for the periodic review of the PM NAAQS:<u>https://www3.epa.gov/ttn/naaqs/standards/pm/data/201604-draft-integratedreview-plan-casac-review.pdf;</u>
  - Proposed schedule calls for completing the review by 2021 (i.e., 9 years after the 2012 review);
  - Comment period on the IRP ends on June 23, 2016;
  - Clean Air Scientific Advisory Committee (CASAC) has scheduled a public teleconference for May 23, 2016 from 2 pm – 6 pm Eastern time to discuss the draft IRP (visit <u>www.epa.gov/casac</u> for more information);

#### • State Implementation Plan Updates

- Houston and Dallas-Fort Worth SIP Revisions Adopted by TCEQ on April 27, 2016;
- April 11, 2016: EPA Administrator extends Houston area attainment date for 2008 ozone NAAQS by 1 year, to July 20, 2016;
- <u>TERP updates</u>
  - Clean Fleet Program awards have been approved and recipients have been notified;
  - Natural Gas Vehicle Grant Program applications are being accepted on first-come, firstserve basis;
